The Social Innovation and Sustainability Thematic Area Group at EGADE Business School, Tecnológico de Monterrey, invites applications for a Postdoctoral Research Fellow to begin August 2023.

This is a full-time 12-month appointment with the possibility of an extension of an equal term or longer. The location of the appointment is Mexico City or Monterrey, Mexico. The position is eligible for benefits, and while it is focused on research activities, teaching opportunities are available for candidates upon request.

The successful candidate would be expected to work with members of the Social Innovation and Sustainability Research Group to develop and conduct research projects related to business and sustainability, corporate social responsibility, and business ethics as well as engage in undergoing projects, publish and communicate research results through various means such as international conferences, webinars, etc. Research activities involve the collection of data, analysis, preparation of project proposals and assistance in fund raising activities.

A candidate must have a doctoral degree or expect to receive a doctoral degree in business, sustainability, or sociology by the start of the appointment. Prior research experience on topics related to corporate social responsibility, sustainability, and ethics is highly desirable. Knowledge of these areas is indispensable. Command of the English language is required and fluency in Spanish is highly desirable.
