Proposals are invited for the following session types:

- Papers: Topics related to business and the three conference themes using a variety of research methods.
- Workshops: Working meetings that focus on specific research or teaching challenge.
- Discussions: Author(s) share an idea that is in the early to middle stages of development but is not yet paper or implementation ready.

Abstracts should be 1-2 pages in length.

The submission deadline is January 31st, 2022, and acceptance of proposals will be announced on February 28th, 2022.
